

## Spelling list: Words ending in *-ice* (copy)

On the end of a word of more than one syllable the /iss/ sound is usually spelled *ice* .

bodice	The <b>bodice</b> of her wedding dress fits perfectly.
hospice	We are raising funds to build a new <b>hospice</b> .
justice	The killer will be brought to <b>justice</b> .
lattice	A <b>lattice</b> is a criss-cross pattern.
malice	I did not feel any <b>malice</b> towards her.
novice	I am a complete <b>novice</b> at the game of darts.
office	I'll call your <b>office</b> to say you are sick.
practice	Top tennis players do hours of <b>practice</b> each day.
service	Call room <b>service</b> to order breakfast.
solstice	The summer <b>solstice</b> is the longest day of the year.
accomplice	The criminal and his <b>accomplice</b> were jailed.
apprentice	The plumbing company employed Jim as an <b>apprentice</b> .
precipice	A vertical cliff is a <b>precipice</b> .
prejudice	It is wrong to show <b>prejudice</b> against people who are different.
