

Spelling list: Non-statutory words: The /n/ sound spelt kn and gn (copy)

The /n/ sound spelt kn and (less often) gn at the beginning of words. The k and g at the beginning of these words was sounded hundreds of years ago.

knock	Knock hard to wake me up.
know	I'm sorry, I don't know your name.
knee	He needs ointment on his cut knee .
gnat	A gnat is a small biting insect.
gnaw	Our dog would gnaw its bone until there was nothing left.
