

Spelling list: Words ending in *ble* (copy)

The /b l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ble* .

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| bible | Do you read the Bible? |
| cable | Is this cable long enough to reach the TV? |
| noble | His bravery was a noble act. |
| table | Please set the table ready for dinner. |
| bobble | The baby's woollen hat has a blue bobble . |
| hobble | My sore ankle made me hobble . |
| wobble | Jellies wobble a lot. |
| nibble | Peter couldn't resist having a nibble of his biscuit. |
| scribble | My little sister did a scribble on the paper. |
| bubble | There was a bubble of soap floating through the kitchen. |
| wobble | Jellies wobble a lot. |
| double | Double click to open the document. |
| trouble | Please take the trouble to get things done well. |
| scrabble | A hen will scrabble in the dust for corn. |
| gamble | In some countries it is against the law to gamble . |
| ramble | We like to ramble through the woods. |
| scramble | The climbers scrambled up the rocky hillside. |
| tumble | Suddenly the old lady took a tumble and fell. |
| grumble | Grandad will grumble about everything. |
