

Spelling list: Words ending in *ble* (copy)

The /b l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *ble* .

bible	Do you read the Bible?
cable	Is this cable long enough to reach the TV?
noble	His bravery was a noble act.
table	Please set the table ready for dinner.
bobble	The baby's woollen hat has a blue bobble .
hobble	My sore ankle made me hobble .
wobble	Jellies wobble a lot.
nibble	Peter couldn't resist having a nibble of his biscuit.
scribble	My little sister did a scribble on the paper.
bubble	There was a bubble of soap floating through the kitchen.
wobble	Jellies wobble a lot.
double	Double click to open the document.
trouble	Please take the trouble to get things done well.
scrabble	A hen will scrabble in the dust for corn.
gamble	In some countries it is against the law to gamble .
ramble	We like to ramble through the woods.
scramble	The climbers scrambled up the rocky hillside.
tumble	Suddenly the old lady took a tumble and fell.
grumble	Grandad will grumble about everything.
