

Spelling list: Words ending in *k/e* (copy)

The /k l/ sound at the end of a word can be spelled *k/e* , especially if the word has only two syllables.

ankle	I have a pain in my right ankle .
crackle	The fire started to crackle in the stove.
shackle	The prisoner was shackled to the wall.
tackle	The referee gave a free kick for a bad tackle .
sparkle	Her crystal beads sparkle in the sunlight.
freckle	Her freckles look very attractive.
heckle	The students decided to heckle the speaker.
speckle	The thrush is a bird with speckled plumage.
fickle	A fickle person changes their mind often.
pickle	I would like a cheese and pickle sandwich.
tickle	The feather will tickle my nose.
prickle	There was a prickle on the bush.
crinkle	The corners of his eyes crinkle when he smiles.
sprinkle	I like to sprinkle some chocolate on my coffee.
twinkle	Twinkle , twinkle little star.
wrinkle	Grandma says she has a new wrinkle every day.
buckle	Most belts tie with a buckle .
suckle	Baby mammals suckle as soon as they are born.
chuckle	He gave a chuckle at the joke.
