

Spelling list: Words ending in *dle* (copy)

The /d l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *dle* .

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| cradle | Each baby was placed in a cradle . |
| ladle | Ladle the soup into a bowl. |
| doodle | The artist was bored so she drew a quick doodle . |
| noodle | I like soya sauce on my noodles. |
| poodle | Her first dog was a poodle . |
| needle | It can be hard to thread a small needle . |
| paddle | It was a beautiful day to paddle in the sea. |
| fiddle | A violin is sometimes called a fiddle . |
| middle | Central Park is in the middle of New York City. |
| riddle | A riddle is a type of word puzzle. |
| cuddle | My baby sisters enjoy having a cuddle . |
| muddle | Jane was confused and got into a muddle . |
| puddle | Small children like to stamp in a puddle . |
| candle | Be careful not to burn yourself on the candle . |
| handle | Please handle the flowers carefully. |
| dwindle | The resort's population will dwindle in winter. |
| swindle | To cheat someone over money is to swindle them. |
| bundle | Put that bundle of washing out to dry. |
| hurdle | She cleared every hurdle in great style. |
