

## Spelling list: Words ending in *dle* (copy)

The /d l/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled *dle* .

cradle	Each baby was placed in a <b>cradle</b> .
ladle	<b>Ladle</b> the soup into a bowl.
doodle	The artist was bored so she drew a quick <b>doodle</b> .
noodle	I like soya sauce on my noodles.
poodle	Her first dog was a <b>poodle</b> .
needle	It can be hard to thread a small <b>needle</b> .
paddle	It was a beautiful day to <b>paddle</b> in the sea.
fiddle	A violin is sometimes called a <b>fiddle</b> .
middle	Central Park is in the <b>middle</b> of New York City.
riddle	A <b>riddle</b> is a type of word puzzle.
cuddle	My baby sisters enjoy having a <b>cuddle</b> .
muddle	Jane was confused and got into a <b>muddle</b> .
puddle	Small children like to stamp in a <b>puddle</b> .
candle	Be careful not to burn yourself on the <b>candle</b> .
handle	Please <b>handle</b> the flowers carefully.
dwindle	The resort's population will <b>dwindle</b> in winter.
swindle	To cheat someone over money is to <b>swindle</b> them.
bundle	Put that <b>bundle</b> of washing out to dry.
hurdle	She cleared every <b>hurdle</b> in great style.
