Spelling list: Words ending in *tle* (copy)

The /t I/ sound at the end of a word is usually spelled tle.

bottle I filled my water **bottle** before we left.

title They couldn't decide on a **title** for the book.

beetle The **beetle** was black and shiny.

battle The soldiers were courageous in **battle** .

cattle The local farmer reared **cattle**.

rattle The baby shook her **rattle**.

kettle He turned on the **kettle**.

nettle Would you like some **nettle** soup?

settle They were unable to **settle** the argument.

little The sea is a **little** way from the path.

brittle Wine glasses can be very **brittle**.

skittle At the bowling alley, I knocked over a **skittle** .

mottle The leaves weren't just one colour, but a **mottle** of dark green and purple.

throttle The engines were at full **throttle**.

scuttle We watch the beetle **scuttle** away.

shuttle The **shuttle** took the astronauts to the space station.

gentle I used a **gentle** soap to cleanse my face.

startle Loud bangs **startle** my dog.

hurtle They **hurtle** to the station, afraid of missing the last train.
