On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /i/ sound is with the letter y .

cry	Children <b>cry</b> when they are upset.
dry	Wait for a <b>dry</b> spell to cut the hay.
fry	Shall we <b>fry</b> that chicken for dinner?
fly	Birds <b>fly</b> high in the sky.
sly	A <b>sly</b> person is underhand and cunning.
spy	James Bond is a <b>spy</b> in many films.
shy	Deer are very <b>shy</b> animals.
why	Please explain <b>why</b> you are late.
apply	He wanted to <b>apply</b> for a new job.
comply	We must <b>comply</b> with the rules about safety.
imply	To <b>imply</b> something is to hint it.
supply	We can <b>supply</b> your order next week.
defy	Rob tried to <b>defy</b> his mother's wishes.
deny	Do not <b>deny</b> that you scratched the car.
rely	You can <b>rely</b> on Brad to be on time.
reply	I need a <b>reply</b> by the weekend.
identify	I could <b>identify</b> him by his very long hair.
magnify	If the print is too small you can <b>magnify</b> it.
multiply	Wild rabbits can <b>multiply</b> very quickly.
