caught	The thief was caught in the act.
fraught	Fraught means upset and worried.
fraught distraught	Fraught means upset and worried. Lily was distraught at losing her pet kitten.
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distraught	Lily was distraught at losing her pet kitten.
distraught naughty	Lily was distraught at losing her pet kitten. Put that naughty child to bed early.
