The letters ought and aught can be used to spell the sound /ort/.

bought He **bought** me a huge bunch of flowers.

brought The lost child was **brought** back home.

thought I **thought** you'd be ready by now.

sought They **sought** the escaped prisoner.

nought Nought means nothing. (US spelling: naught).

caught The thief was **caught** in the act.

fraught Fraught means upset and worried.

distraught Lily was **distraught** at losing her pet kitten.

naughty Put that **naughty** child to bed early.

haughty A **haughty** person thinks a lot of herself.

daughter Our daughter has fair hair.

slaughter The army tried to stop the **slaughter** .
