

## Spelling list: Year 2 Autumn Week 12 Spelling List

This week's spelling pattern / rule is: Words ending in 'y' when making plurals Rule: We change the "y" to "ie" when adding the suffix ending s if a word ends in a consonant + Y. Baby= babies If the word ends in a vowel (a,e,i,o,u) + y then just add s e.g. boy - boys, journey - journeys, key - keys. If the word ends in a consonant + y then 'y' changes to ies (see examples below).

babies	<b>Babies</b> like to drink milk.
ladies	The <b>ladies</b> were wearing funny hats.
puppies	<b>Puppies</b> are usually playful.
jellies	Her favourite sweets were the fruit-flavoured <b>jellies</b> .
parties	I have been invited to two <b>parties</b> this weekend.
pennies	The sweets only cost a few <b>pennies</b> .
hobbies	I was asked by my teacher to list all of my <b>hobbies</b> .
lorries	The noisy <b>lorries</b> drive on the road.
bunnies	The <b>bunnies</b> were jumping about everywhere.
poppies	Grandpa grew <b>poppies</b> in his garden.
eye	Two e's in <b>eye</b> - one for each eye!
fast	The train went really <b>fast</b> .
