primacy

encoding Changing information so that it can be stored.

storage Holding information in the memory system.

retrieval Recovering information from storage.

sensory Hold information received from the senses for a very short period of time.

recency Information the is received later is recalled better than earlier information.

Remembering words from the beginning of a list is known as the **primacy**

effect.

reconstructive Altering our recollection of things so that they make more sense to us.

structural Thinking about the physical appearance of the words to be learnt.

phonetic Thinking about the sound of the words to be learnt.
