

Spelling list: oi and oy words (copy)

In one-syllable words, there are two ways of spelling the /oi/ sound: oi and oy. Use oi in the middle of a word and oy at the end. This list will help you practise spelling the oi sound in a mixture of oi and oy words.

boil Will you **boil** the kettle for tea?

foil They wrapped the sandwiches in **foil** .

soil This garden **soil** is good quality.

spoil Please don't **spoil** the game by cheating.

toil He began to **toil** up the hill.

coin The **coin** featured the monarch's profile.

join The musician had to audition to **join** the band.

loin People who like to eat meat love eating a tenderloin.

joint Your elbow is a hinge **joint** .

void **Void** means empty or invalid.

hoist Raise or **hoist** something up with ropes and pulleys.

joist We need a wooden **joist** above the door to support the ceiling.

moist This chocolate cake is very **moist** .

choice There's a **choice** of four desserts.

voice His **voice** was very faint.

noise Did you hear that strange **noise** ?

boy The **boy** ate some cake.

joy The baby has brought them great **joy** .

toy She loved her **toy** train.
