Roots ending in a vowel or suffixes starting with a vowel

shiniest The girl's hair clip was the **shiniest** in the class.

shinier My shoes are **shinier** than yours.

shiny My shoes are always **shiny** .

shining Luckily, the sun was **shining** .

nicer The chocolate cake is **nicer** than the plain cake.

nicest The **nicest** flower to appear in spring is the crocus.

nicely Dress **nicely** or you may be refused admission.

niceness **Niceness** is always appreciated.

hiker The injured **hiker** was helped to safety.

hiking The family was very keen on **hiking** .

hiked The boy **hiked** all the way to the top of the hill.

scarily The prophet's predictions were **scarily** accurate.

scary Walking in the forest was **scary** .

scaring Stop **scaring** me!

scared The whole village was **scared** of the ogre.

scarier Bungee jumps are **scarier** in real life.

scariest The **scariest** film ever is coming to cinemas soon.
