

Spelling list: OW Words

On the end of a word the most common way to spell the long /o/ sound is with the letters ow.

blow	Blow out the candles on your cake.
flow	The crowd will flow through the gates.
show	Tick the box to show you have read the text.
throw	Don't throw your clothes on the floor.
arrow	The archer was down to his last arrow .
below	He lives in the rooms below me.
borrow	Could I borrow some milk?
elbow	A blow on the elbow can be painful.
fellow	That fellow keeps looking at me.
follow	Don't follow me, I'm lost.
hollow	The tree trunk was hollow .
narrow	Our car got stuck in a narrow lane.
pillow	I like to sleep with a big pillow .
sorrow	Sorrow is a feeling of great sadness.
tomorrow	I'll call you again tomorrow .
