

## Spelling list: -sure and -ture suffix 6th Feb 2017 YR4

Rules: The ending sounding like zur are always spelt sure. The ending sounding like chur are often spelt ture, but check that the word is not a root word ending in (t)ch with an ending e.g teacher or catcher, richer or stretcher

measure	A gallon is an imperial <b>measure</b> of volume.

pleasure	It gives me great <b>pleasure</b> to be here today.
enclosure	An aircraft's canopy is the transparent cockpit <b>enclosure</b> .

ensure	In the US, during the prohibition era 1920 -1933, the sale, manufacture and transport of alcohol was prohibited, to <b>ensure</b> that Americans could not consume alcohol.

creature	A crocodile is a very dangerous <b>creature</b> .
furniture	A suite is a set e.g. of rooms or <b>furniture</b> .
picture	Use tacks to fix the <b>picture</b> frame.
nature	The explorer was audacious by <b>nature</b> .
adventure	The walker set out on his hundredth <b>adventure</b> .
peace	If the baby is asleep there is <b>peace</b> and quiet.
piece	Please may I have a <b>piece</b> of cake?
weigh	<b>Weigh</b> it in grammes, not ounces.
whey	The cheese maker separated all the curds from the <b>whey</b> .
