Rules: The ending sounding like zur are always spelt sure. The ending sounding like chur are often spelt ture, but check that the word is not a root word ending in (t)ch with an ending e.g teacher or catcher, richer or stretcher

measure A gallon is an imperial **measure** of volume.

treasure All the family took part in the **treasure** hunt.

pleasure It gives me great **pleasure** to be here today.

enclosure An aircraft's canopy is the transparent cockpit **enclosure** .

leisure In my **leisure** time I enjoy swimming.

ensure In the US, during the prohibition era 1920 -1933, the sale, manufacture and transport of alcohol was prohibited, to **ensure** that Americans could not consume alcohol.

reassure A phone call from my mom would **reassure** me.

creature A crocodile is a very dangerous **creature** .

furniture A suite is a set e.g. of rooms or **furniture** .

picture Use tacks to fix the **picture** frame.

nature The explorer was audacious by **nature** .

adventure The walker set out on his hundredth **adventure** .

peace If the baby is asleep there is **peace** and quiet.

piece Please may I have a **piece** of cake?

weigh **Weigh** it in grammes, not ounces.

whey The cheese maker separated all the curds from the **whey** .
