naivety	Naivety is a lack of experience and wisdom.
bravery	Bravery is courage in daunting situations.
ransom	A ransom is money that is paid for the release of a captive prisoner.
medieval	The middle ages (roughly 1000 - 1500).
chivalry	Chivalry is polite and courteous behaviour, particularly towards women.
chivalrous	Knights were known to be gallant and chivalrous .
timeless	Not affected by the passage of time or changes in fashion. Arthur's stories are timeless because the themes apply to the modern day.
honour	Honour is the quality of knowing and doing what is morally right.
moral	The moral of a story is the lesson learnt by the reader based on the actions or mistakes made by the characters.
immoral	To be immoral is to behave terribly.
legends	Legends are extremely famous or notorious mythical characters, such as Arthur.
dominant	To be dominant is to have power and influence over others and to use it.
submissive	To be submissive is to be obedient and ready to conform to the will of others.
duel	A duel is a battle between two people. E.g, the swordsmen fought a duel .
deception	Deception is the action of tricking somebody by lying to them.
deceive	That liar tried to deceive me.
military	A country's army is sometimes referred to as the military .
