

## Spelling list: R8 Week 10 Soft g spellings

Rule: Use dge to protect a short vowel sound with no letter friend after it, e.g. fridge . Use ge where the vowel does have a letter friend after it, e.g. fringe . Use g e where the vowel is a long sound (says its name), e.g. page .

edge	There is a sheer drop at the cliff <b>edge</b> .
ledge	Place the flower on window <b>ledge</b> .
bridge	The <b>bridge</b> went over the river down below.
fridge	I put the milk in the <b>fridge</b> .
ridge	You can see for miles from the mountain <b>ridge</b> .
fudge	<b>Fudge</b> is made from sugar, butter and milk.
judge	The <b>judge</b> sent him to jail for a year.
cage	We keep our rabbit in a <b>cage</b> .
page	Turn over to the next <b>page</b> .
average	The <b>average</b> age of children in the class is eight.
damage	Litter and pollution can <b>damage</b> the environment.
garage	They work at a <b>garage</b> .
