

Spelling list: R8 Week 10 Soft g spellings

Rule: Use dge to protect a short vowel sound with no letter friend after it, e.g. fridge . Use ge where the vowel does have a letter friend after it, e.g. fringe . Use g e where the vowel is a long sound (says its name), e.g. page .

edge	There is a sheer drop at the cliff edge .
ledge	Place the flower on window ledge .
bridge	The bridge went over the river down below.
fridge	I put the milk in the fridge .
ridge	You can see for miles from the mountain ridge .
fudge	Fudge is made from sugar, butter and milk.
