agribusiness	<b>Agribusiness</b> Is farming on an industrial, commercially viable scale.
carbon	Our <b>carbon</b> footprint is the measurement of all of the greenhouse gases we individually produce.
energy	<b>Energy</b> mix refers to the range of primary <b>energy</b> sources in a country.
footprint	Carbon <b>footprint</b> is expressed as tonnes or kilograms of carbon dioxide.
fossil	<b>Fossil</b> fuels are non renewable energy resources.
management	For resource <b>management</b> to be sustainable, the resource must never be depleted or exhausted.
miles	Food <b>miles</b> is the total distance food is transported from production to meeting the consumer.
organic	<b>Organic</b> farming uses only sustainable natural methods to produce food.
resource	<b>Resource</b> management is the sustainable management of natural resources.
sourcing	Local food <b>sourcing</b> is a method of food <b>sourcing</b> on a local rather than national or international scale.
