agribusiness	Agribusiness Is farming on an industrial, commercially viable scale.
carbon	Our carbon footprint is the measurement of all of the greenhouse gases we individually produce.
energy	Energy mix refers to the range of primary energy sources in a country.
footprint	Carbon footprint is expressed as tonnes or kilograms of carbon dioxide.
fossil	Fossil fuels are non renewable energy resources.
management	For resource management to be sustainable, the resource must never be depleted or exhausted.
miles	Food miles is the total distance food is transported from production to meeting the consumer.
organic	Organic farming uses only sustainable natural methods to produce food.
resource	Resource management is the sustainable management of natural resources.
sourcing	Local food sourcing is a method of food sourcing on a local rather than national or international scale.
