using electricity

fuse	A <b>fuse</b> in a plug is a piece of wire that melts if too much electricity flows through it.
atom	An <b>atom</b> is the smallest part of an element.
electron	An <b>electron</b> is a negatively charged particle that orbits the nucleus of an atom.
series	A circuit with all the bulbs in one loop is called a <b>series</b> circuit.
parallel	A <b>parallel</b> circuit is where the bulbs are on separate branches of a circuit.
impulse	When you move, your brain send electrical signals, called impulses, to your nerves.
nerves	The impulses travel along your <b>nerves</b> .
shock	An electric <b>shock</b> can burn the skin, or can stop our nerves from working properly.
