

Spelling list: Longer words with //

This word list highlights the use of double / in longer words. The essential rule here is to double the / when it comes after a short vowel sound.

Examples worth noting:

cellar : In this word, the double / follows the short vowel e .

ballot : The double / follows the short /a/ sound.

bollard : This time, a short /o/ is followed by the letters //

As you explore these words, consider incorporating them into your own sentences. This practice will not only reinforce the spelling rule but also enhance your vocabulary and overall writing skills.

cellar The wine will keep cool in the **cellar** .

bollard The **bollard** prevented the car from parking.

hillock We walked to the top of the **hillock** .

ballot Glen got most votes in the **ballot** .
