Suffix -tion, -sion

affect	The government cuts will <b>affect</b> everyone.
affection	He showed a great deal of <b>affection</b> to her.
pollute	Chimney smoke and car fumes <b>pollute</b> the air we breathe, making it unsafe for us to inhale.
pollution	Air <b>pollution</b> is bad in many cities.
express	The actress expressed a gamut of emotions.
expression	His facial expressions are comical.
direct	<b>Direct</b> speech involves the narrator giving the exact words spoken (or thought) by the character, almost always enclosed in speech marks, and often (but not always) with a reporting clause (such as 'said Jim').
direction	Head in a northerly <b>direction</b> .
ordinary	It began as an <b>ordinary</b> day...
particular	I like that dress in <b>particular</b> .
