spontaneous	Spontaneous prayers are prayers spoken from the heart in the moment.
Stations	Stations of the Cross are a series of fourteen images depicting Jesus from his condemnation to his burial.
stewardship	Stewardship refers to humanity's duty to preserve the environment on behalf of God.
sustainability	Sustainability is the development of ways of living which conserve natural resources with minimal impact on future generations.
