saving	In Judaism, <b>saving</b> a life is known as Pikuach Nefesh.
Shabbat	<b>Shabbat</b> is the Jewish holy day from sunset on Friday until sunset on Saturday.
Sinai	<b>Sinai</b> is the mountain where Moses received the Law from God.
synagogue	The <b>synagogue</b> is the Jewish place of public worship.
Talmud	The Oral law or 'Talmud' is word of God given to Moses but not written down for centuries.
Tenakh	<b>Tenakh</b> refers to the Jewish scriptures in three parts: Torah, Nevi'im and Ketuvim.
Trefah	<b>Trefah</b> refers to food that is not Kosher and is therefore forbidden by God.
Yom	<b>Yom</b> Kippur is the holiest day of the Jewish year.
