Fourth general English keywords list.

style	<b>Style</b> is the vocabulary and language used; for example, formal or informal language, simple or complicated vocabulary.
theme	<b>Theme</b> is the key idea of a piece; for example, racism or survival.
paragraph	A <b>paragraph</b> is a sentence or group of sentences based around one idea.
introduction	The <b>introduction</b> is a group of sentences at the beginning of a piece of writing, giving the reader an idea of what is to come.
conclusion	The <b>conclusion</b> is a group of sentences at the end of a piece of writing, bringing it to a satisfying end.
extract	An <b>extract</b> is a short piece of writing taken from a book, play or longer piece of writing.
phrase	A <b>phrase</b> is a group of words within a sentence that only make sense with the help of the rest of the sentence.
summary	A <b>summary</b> is a short statement giving the main points of a longer piece of writing.
vocabulary	<b>Vocabulary</b> is the words used in a piece of writing or speech.
context	To know the <b>context</b> of something is to be able to understand it by considering what is going on around it.
objective	To be <b>objective</b> is to give an opinion not based on personal feeling but on fact.
subjective	To be <b>subjective</b> is to give an opinion based on personal feelings.
narrative	The <b>narrative</b> tells the story of something that has happened in the correct order.
	To <b>portray</b> is to make a picture of, or describe in words, somebody or

portray something.
