General keywords list for Maths.

ADD	To ADD is to join one number to another; other words used include plus and total.
subtract	Subtract is to take away one number from another; other words include minus or find the difference.
multiply	Multiply is to make a number bigger by a given number of times; for example, two lots of three make six.
divide	Divide is to find out how often a number is found in another; for example, there are three lots of four in twelve.
increase	To increase is to make something bigger.
decrease	To decrease is to make something smaller.
digit	A digit is any of the numbers 0 to 9.
equation	An equation is a mathematical way of showing how two things are equal.
equivalent	Equivalent means equal or the same in value.
sequence	A sequence are numbers that follow each other in a particular order.
consecutive	Consecutive means following one after the other.
approximate	To approximate is to give an answer that is close to the exact answer.
accurate	Accurate means exact or correct.
inverses	Inverses are opposites; for example, minus is the opposite of plus.
value	Value is what or how much something is worth.
