Odd numbers are numbers that give a remainder when divided by two.

A prime number is a number that doesn't divide by anything except one.

Factor - also called a divisor - is a whole number that divides exactly into another number.

Multiples are numbers in their own times table; for example, six, nine, twelve are all multiples of three.

Average is the total divided by how many numbers added together.

Mean is another word for average: the total divided by how many numbers added together.

A square number is a number multiplied by itself.

A cube number is a number multiplied by itself three times.

The square root is the number that when multiplied by itself is the given number; for example three is the square root of nine.

The decimal is a bit more or less than a whole number, written using a point; for example, 2.5.

A recurring number is a number that goes on forever; for example, a third of ten is 3 point 33 recurring .
