Second general Maths keywords list.

integer	An integer is a whole number.
even	Even numbers are numbers that divide by two without remainder.
odd	Odd numbers are numbers that give a remainder when divided by two.
negative	Negative numbers are number less than zero.
positive	Positive numbers are numbers more than zero.
prime	A prime number is a number that doesn't divide by anything except one.
factor	Factor - also called a divisor - is a whole number that divides exactly into another number.
multiples	Multiples are numbers in their own times table; for example, six, nine, twelve are all multiples of three.
average	Average is the total divided by how many numbers added together.
mean	Mean is another word for average: the total divided by how many numbers added together.
square	A square number is a number multiplied by itself.
cube	A cube number is a number multiplied by itself three times.
root	The square root is the number that when multiplied by itself is the given number; for example three is the square root of nine.
decimal	The decimal is a bit more or less than a whole number, written using a point; for example, 2.5.
recurring	A recurring number is a number that goes on forever; for example, a third of ten is 3 point 33 recurring .
