Words an aircraft engineer is likely to need when writing maintenance reports.

accordance	If something is in <b>accordance</b> with regulations, it means it is conforming with them.
ailerons	<b>Ailerons</b> are airfoils that control lateral motion during a flight.
aircraft	An <b>aircraft</b> is a vehicle that can fly.
battery	A <b>battery</b> is a device that produces electricity.
bracket	A <b>bracket</b> is a support projecting from a wall.
brakes	<b>Brakes</b> are devices made up of a combination of interacting parts that work to slow a motor vehicle.
canopy	An aircraft's <b>canopy</b> is the transparent cockpit enclosure.
carbon	<b>Carbon</b> fiber is a material used to build modern planes.
carburetor	A <b>carburetor</b> is used in aircraft engines to blend air and fuel.
catalogue	Please send me a copy of your <b>catalogue</b> .
change	A <b>change</b> is the process through which something becomes different.
chapter	A <b>chapter</b> is a subdivision of a written work.
cockpit	The <b>cockpit</b> is the compartment where the pilot sits while flying the aircraft.
column	A <b>column</b> is a tall vertical cylindrical structure that stands upright and is used to support a structure.
control	A <b>control</b> is a mechanism that controls the operation of a machine.
cylinder	A <b>cylinder</b> is a cylindrical container for oxygen or compressed air.
degrees	<b>Degrees</b> are a measure for arcs and angles and a unit of temperature on a specified scale.
