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| area | An area is the extent of a two-dimensional surface enclosed within a boundary. |
| cubic | If something is cubic , it has three dimensions. |
| metric | The metric system is a system of measurement. |
| centimetre | I need to shorten my jeans by one centimetre . |
| foot | A foot is a linear unit of length equal to twelve inches or a third of a yard. |
| inch | An inch is one twelfth of a foot. |
| kilometre | A kilometre is a thousand metres. |
| metre | One hundred centimetres make a metre . |
| mile | A mile is a unit of length equivalent to 1609.344 meters. |
| millimetre | One thousandth of a metre is a millimetre . |
| measure | A measure is a quantifiable amount of something. |
| yard | A yard is equal to three feet. |
| gallon | A gallon is equal to four quarts. |
| litre | This flask holds one litre of juice. |
| quantity | Quantity refers to how much there is or how many there are of something. |
| gram | A gram is one thousandth of a kilogram. |
