affairs	<b>Affairs</b> in this context are matters that are a particular person's concern or responsibility.
resembled	If two people <b>resembled</b> each other, it would mean that they looked very similar. For example, Viola <b>resembled</b> her twin brother Sebastian.
misdemeanour	A <b>misdemeanour</b> is a minor wrong doing but it is not illegal.
distressed	If someone is <b>distressed</b> , they are feeling anxious.
countess	A <b>countess</b> is an important woman that is the wife of a count or earl.
baffled	To be <b>baffled</b> is to be confused or bewildered.
fretful	To be <b>fretful</b> is to express distress and worry.
uncivilised	If someone is described as being <b>uncivilised</b> , they are impolite, rude and behave in a socially unacceptable manner.
vile	If something is <b>vile</b> , it is disgusting and extremely unpleasant.
quailed	<b>Quailed</b> is verb which means to show fear or apprehension through body language.
fraught	If someone is described as <b>fraught</b> , they are affected by anxiety or stress.
reef	A <b>reef</b> is the jagged rock and coral found on the seabed in the ocean.
trunk	A <b>trunk</b> is a large box used for transporting clothes.
page	In Twelfth Night, a <b>page</b> is a young male attendant or servant.
