addiction	<b>Addiction</b> is a state of dependence on a particular substance or habit.

crime	A <b>crime</b> is an illegal action against a person, property or country.

deterrence	Punishment is used as a <b>deterrence</b> against crime.
forgiveness	<b>Forgiveness</b> is letting go of resentment or vengeance towards a person or group.
greed	<b>Greed</b> is the want or desire for more.
hate	<b>Hate</b> crimes are crimes based on prejudice views such as racism.
illness	Mental <b>illness</b> can be a cause of crime or erratic behaviour.
intentions	Evil <b>intentions</b> are desires to hurt or cause harm.
law	The <b>law</b> is a set of rules issued by a country for citizens to live by.
